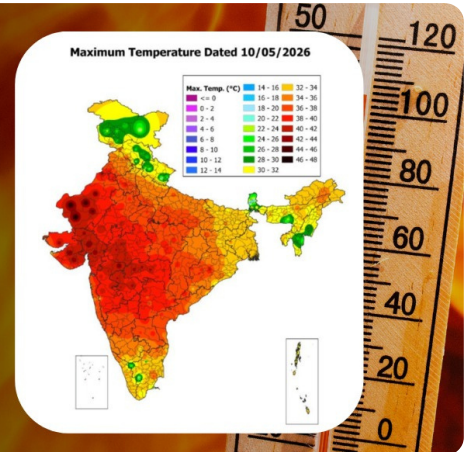

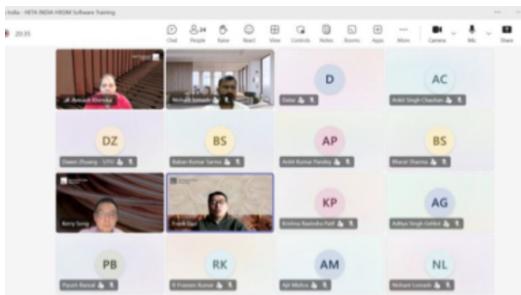
The importance of compliance to codes and standards for ensuring safety and reliability of electrical infrastructure in Indian data centres in an industry-led initiative were discussed.
